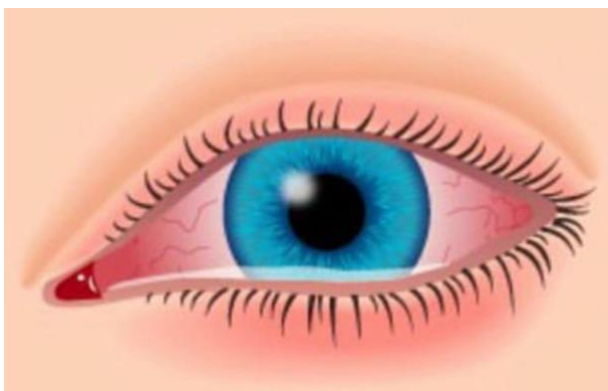


## Allergic Conjunctivitis

Allergic conjunctivitis is an eye inflammation caused by an allergic reaction to substances like pollen, dust, mold spores, animal dander, or chemicals. Unlike viral conjunctivitis ("pink eye"), allergic conjunctivitis affects both eyes and is not contagious.



### Signs and Symptoms

1. Red, itchy, watery, and burning eyes
2. Swollen eyelids
3. Sensitivity to light
4. Accompanied by nasal congestion and sneezing
