
Cataract

A cataract is a clouding of the normally clear lens of your eye. Cataracts can affect one or both eyes and are common in older people. Most cataracts develop slowly and don't disturb your eyesight early on. Risk factors of a cataract include diabetes, smoking, alcohol use, and prolonged exposure to sunlight.



Signs and Symptoms

- 1. Cloudy or blurry vision
- 2. Seeing "halos" around lights
- 3. Poor night vision
- 4. Double vision
- 5. Fading of colors
